

Assistant Professor or Associate Professor of Mathematics

The Department of at Stillman College invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. Applicant should have a doctoral degree in mathematics.

Experience and required qualifications:

- Ph.D. degree in any area of mathematics (Ph.D. candidates may be considered provided evidence that all degree requirements will be completed by time of appointment.).
- Evidence of successful college/university traditional and online instruction.
- Evidence of successful research development (conference presentations, publications, professional/organizational membership(s), etc.) relevant to the field.

Responsibilities of the successful applicant include the following:

- Teach 12 to 15 credit hours each semester based upon departmental need. Courses include quantitative literacy (freshman math), algebra, trigonometry, geometry, calculus as well as upper level mathematics courses based on student need.
- Incorporate active student learning and appropriate technology-use in the classroom.
- Advise and mentor student majors as they matriculate through the curriculum established for mathematics.
- Engage in service activities relevant to the applicant's field of study as well as to the mission of the department, the division, and the college.
- Engage in professional development activities (grant writing, conference presentations, workshops, etc.) contributive to the field and the college.

- Cover letter that addresses applicant's teaching philosophy as well as interests to apply to Stillman College;
- Curriculum Vitae of all educational and professional experiences;
- Copies of transcripts (at the time of the application-submission, unofficial copies are welcomed that include degree received and conferred date; however, the successful applicant must provide official copies of transcript to file with the institution); and

- List of three current professional references with name, relationship to applicant, address, email address, and telephone number. Letters of recommendation will not be accepted in lieu of the list of professional references.

NOTE: A background search will be required of the successful applicant.
