- Teach survey courses and upper-level courses in Criminal Justice, based on the need of the department.

Application instructions:

For consideration of the position, all applicants must include the following items in their application packages, which may be submitted electronically via Stillman College's "Employment" Webpage--<https://stillman.edu/about-us/human-resources/employment/>-- and/or submitted via email to the Director of Human Resources at lgoins@stillman.edu:

- Completed application for employment (downloadable application: <https://stillman.edu/about-us/human-resources/employment/>);
- Cover letter that addresses applicant's teaching philosophy as well as interests in teaching at Stillman College;
- Curriculum Vitae of all educational and professional experiences;
- Copies of transcripts (at the time of submitting the application, unofficial copies are welcomed that include degree received and conferred date; however, the successful applicant must provide official copies of transcripts to file with the institution); and
- List of three current professional references with name, relationship to applicant, address, email address, and telephone number. Letters of recommendation will not be accepted in lieu of the list of professional references.

NOTE: A background search will be required of the successful applicant.
