Instructor of Psychology

Minimum Requirements: Master's degree or earned doctorate (Ph.D.) in Psychology, with previous experience teaching undergraduate courses in psychology, using technology in the classroom, and teaching online courses. One should also have a commitment to teaching that is consistent with the College's vision and mission. Additionally, the successful candidate should have the ability to contribute to a positive work environment at the College.

Duties: The successful applicant will teach various undergraduate psychology courses which may include Introduction to Psychology, as well as advanced/upper level Psychology courses. Summer school teaching assignments may be available.
