Policy Statement:

When a student/service member stops attending, Stillman College will return any unearned Tuition Assistance (TA) funds received from the Department of Defense on a proportional basis through at least the 60 percent portion of the period for which the funds were provided. The funds are being returned to the Military Department and not to the student/service member.

Procedures for Implementation:

The returned TA funds will be calculated on a proportional basis as outlined below based upon the point during the semester when the student/service member stops attending or withdraws from a course.
