### **Indicators Used**

INDICATOR	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED
Graduation Rate	The calculated percentage of first-time, full-time undergraduate business administration majors who completed their program within six years (i.e., a 150% completion time). Fall 2019's cohort of first-time freshmen is the data used for this graduation rate within 150% completion time. (Total number of graduates (7) divided by total number of full-time, first-time business administration freshmen in fall 2019 (29) provides the quotient (0.241), which then is multiplied by 100 (24.1) and rounded to the nearest one (24%); $7 / 29 = 0.241 \times 100 = 24\%$ ).
